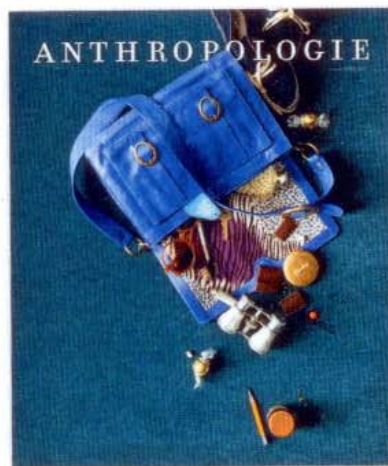


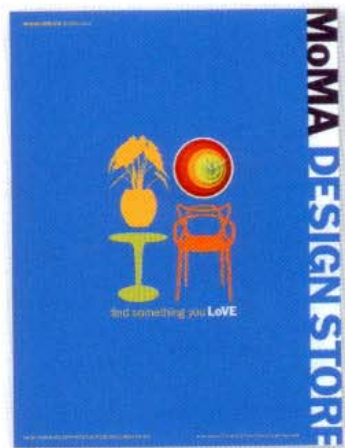
9 of the best... Catalogues, for smart shopping from your sofa
